 - Three routines
 - Would give the teams more opportunity to dance
 - Would make the state competition a longer event
 - Numbers would change and 1-4A teams could suffer
 - More opportunities to dance would allow divisions to grow could prevent collapsing
 - Format change start earlier? go longer?

- Transparency to help each other through the process
- Divisions would not have collapsed with one or two more performances
- Consider how to qualify would we be able to change it to lower than 70?
- Based on proposal two would need to qualify and one would be automatic

- Would be a great opportunity to add a third routine for the teams
- Saving 1-4A teams feels hopeless that they can't compete because the divisions would collapse

- Football is able to do a smaller team in the 1-3a teams
- Six categories
 - Once OSAA takes away, it will most likely not come back
 - Could we break apart traditional to lyrical/contemporary and modern
 - Move forward with modern or a replacement of some sort
 - Game day?
